

MY ANCESTORS

This is the information that I received from my Aunt Mary on my father's side of the family.

My Grandfather Frantisek Halamka was born October 31, 1877 in the town of Kladno in the district of Hlinsko. His Uncle George Halamka a shoemaker taught my Grandfather the trade. Frantisek Halamka married Frantiska Sinkorova on February 25, 1900. My Grandfather Halamka came over to America in 1908 from Krouna Czechoslovakia. He landed at New York. He went to Racine, Wisconsin where he worked for a shoe factory. After he worked in the shoe factory for awhile he quit and got a job in a shoe store. He repaired shoes for the people of the neighborhood at home. In 1920 he bought a shoe store and repair shop. He discontinued the shoe store but continued his repair shop until he died October 17, 1942.

My Grandmother, Frantiska Halamka was born April 9, 1878. She came over to America with three children in 1909. The children were my Uncle Frank, Aunt Mary and Henry, my father.

My Great Grandfather was George Halamka. He was a farmer. He married my Great Grandmother Frantiska Skalova. They had four children, George Jr., Frank, Francea, and Anna.

Great Uncle George Halamka was a shoemaker. He married Katherine Sucha. They had three children, Frank who was a quarry worker, Joseph who was a carpet weaver and Marie who married James Vacek. He worked in a paper mill. Marie worked in a candle factory. She did hand painting on candles until she became ill a few years ago. They had two children George and Maruska.

Great Grandfather George's daughter Frances married John Pavlis, a mason by trade. Daughter Anna married Frank Havelka, a tailor. This Frank Havelka was an uncle of Mrs. Vincent Pnyk who also came to Racine from Bohemia.

My Grandmother Halamka gave me some information about her family through Aunt Mary. My Great, Great Grandmother was Anna Cerny. She married John Novak, who was a wood

by trade. They had three children, one boy, John Jr. who died during the 1st World War and two girls Katherine and Anna, who is my Great Grandmother.
